HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Purpose

We aim to conduct our business in a safe and socially responsible manner through strong leadership and effective management of occupational health and safety.

In addition, as a target, the Group is dedicated to using stringent measures throughout our business to maintain no work-related fatality or injury.

As Employer

The Group is committed to:

- providing adequate and appropriate resources to implement this Policy;
- complying with all applicable laws, regulations, standards and codes of practices;
- providing and maintaining a safe working environment;
- providing adequate and appropriate trainings to employees in respect of their responsibilities and duties for carrying out the work safely;
- raising the awareness of our employees and business partners of all the applicable health and safety best practices;
- embedding health and safety in the design, planning and conduct of all business activities;
- implementing action plan that involves workers in identifying, evaluating, and prioritising health and safety risks as necessary, while conducting corrective measures to minimise hazards across all business activities ensuring adherence to occupational health and safety standards and achieving its targets;
- monitoring and reviewing health and safety performance regularly;
- setting the Group’s quantitative targets to enhance health and safety performance metrics;
- reviewing and improving the effectiveness of management systems in terms of the health and safety performance continually;
- conducting regular safety inspections and audits with a view to proactively identifying unsafe practices or activities and ensuring compliance with this Policy; and
- ensuring this Policy and performance are well communicated to all interested stakeholders.

As Employee

The employees are required to:

- follow health and safety procedures and instructions relevant to their work;
- undertake work that they are well-trained and competent;
- operate equipment that they are trained and authorised to operate;
- take reasonable care of their own health and safety and considering the safety and health of others who may be affected by their acts; and
- report to the management promptly all identified hazards, incidents, injuries, and work conditions that are unsafe or unhealthy in verbal and written form.

Review of this Policy

The Company will review this Policy from time to time as appropriate, and in any event, once every three years.
